As a result, you should have all necessary documentation in hand when needed.

- ✧ Send the following items to our office (see address above):
 - ✧ Student Application
 - ✧ \$50 Non-refundable application fee
 - ✧ Student's report card from previous year as well as any testing (SAT, CAT, PSAT or ISTEP) scores.
- ✧ Your child will be tested. We will contact you for the testing appointment. (If you submit SAT, CAT or ISTEP scores from the past year, further testing may not be necessary.)
- ✧ An interview will be held with the parents and the student after the test has been scored. The student and both parents are expected for the conference. Following the conference, a decision will be made regarding admission and you will be notified.
- ✧ After admission, the parents should plan to make a financial agreement with the school. Please contact the office.

PARENT AGREEMENT:

In consideration of The King's Academy and upon acceptance of our child _____, we agree to the following:

- ❖ To pledge our fullest cooperation to keep doctrinal controversy out of the school.
- ❖ To agree that if our child becomes involved in any trouble at school or if we disagree with any policy set by the school, we will in no case complain to any other parent, but in Christian love and prayer, will feel free to discuss such concerns only with the parties involved. If such action does not lead to a resolution, to follow the Biblical guidelines for conflict resolution outlined in Matthew 18:15-17.
- ❖ To fully make our tuition payments on or before time due. We understand all tuition must be paid for one semester before our child may continue the next semester and that report cards will be withheld at the end of the school year if financial obligations are not paid in full.
- ❖ To compensate for all damage done by our child, either intentionally or accidentally, to school property (such as breakage of windows, abuse of books, etc.).
- ❖ To encourage our child to comply with the school program and regulations.
- ❖ To understand that upon entering The King's Academy each student will undergo a one-year probationary period during which evaluations may occur as needed. A student's continued enrollment is contingent upon a satisfactory academic and discipline record.
- ❖ To hereby invest authority in the school to discipline our child (after discussion with us) as seems wise and expedient. The final step in The King's Academy discipline procedure is student dismissal. This will come about after a student has received disciplinary probation, which means that a parent has been notified that the student has repeatedly violated rules set up by the school or classroom teacher.
- ❖ To understand that the standards of TKA do not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor of God and the Bible, or disrespect to the personnel or students of The King's Academy.
- ❖ That policies and regulations may change between the time of application and the beginning of classes. An effort will be made to notify parents of any such changes.
- ❖ To agree with TKA's Statement of Faith and be willing to have our child instructed according to it.
- ❖ To read and support TKA's guidelines for students as outlined in the student handbook.
- ❖ To provide lunch or pay for provided hot lunches for my student(s). TKA does not participate in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program.
- ❖ To provide or make transportation arrangements to and from school for my student(s).
- ❖ In the event our child becomes ill or is injured while under school supervision, to authorize the school authorities to take the following steps:
 1. *Contact a parent of the student and follow his/her wishes.*
 2. *In the event that neither parent can be reached, contact the student's physician and follow his/her instructions.*
 3. *In the event that the student's parent or physician cannot be reached, contact a properly licensed practicing physician and follow his/her instruction. This could include emergency measures and directives from Marion General Hospital.*

We hereby agree to relieve the school and any of its employees from any liabilities in connection with these instructions.
